d. CUF Raffle Tickets: The school made $\$ 9255$.
e. Paschal Meal: Went well, very organized
f. $\mathbf{5 K}$ Walk/Run: Friday May $3^{\text {rd }}$. As of $4 / 18$ there were 60 registered.
g. Golf Tournament: Chairs and committee have been meeting, preparation is going well.
h. Snow Ball: The Suchy and Winkels Families are planning to step down as chairs after the 2020 event. Open to suggestions on how to help the event raise additional funds (the 2019 event raised roughly $\$ 38,400$ ). Discussed location, but limited when keeping it local, also would like to look at different meal options for next year.
i. Bookfair: Joe has created time slots for the volunteers when signing up. Would like to be sure the gathering area is reserved next time so it will not have to be taken down and put back up (aware that funerals are the exception).
j. CUF Breakfast: Maria stated the check came recently for roughly $\$ 1600$.
k. School Dance: Went Well
I. Service-A-Thon or Walk-A-Thon: Tentative date 10/16/19, looking for chair.

## Action Items

a. Church Festival: Would like to show a presence at the parish festival in August, a large amount (roughly $\$ 170,000$ ) comes from Seven Dolors to support the school. Hoping families will volunteer.
b. HFS School supplies: In the past H\&S has supplied many items. For the upcoming school year, the teachers have asked at instead of sketch pads, we supply quality water colors.
c. Breakfast Program: Hoping to get $\$ 200 / \mathrm{mo}$ ( $\$ 1800 /$ year) to help supplement the breakfast program (the cost of food has been covered by the state, but not any additional costs such as wages. Was suggested to add to add it to the draft budget.
d. Snacks: Will ask families to bring as needed, as it is anticipated to have roughly the same lunch times for the next school year as currently have.
e. Teacher/Staff/School Wish List Items: Approve 3 online educational program subscriptions for 3-6 grades (up to $\$ 500$ ) for the $19-20$ budget. Also, a rug for $2^{\text {nd }}$ grade classroom (roughly \$70 from Misc Budget).
