MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL

St Patrick's other famous miracle, the banishment of the snakes, is supposed to have occurred following his Great Fast on the mount Croagh Patrick, outside Westport in County Mayo. St Patrick climbed the mountain where he fasted for 40 days, before expelling all the snakes from Ireland. The fact is that there were never actually any snakes in Ireland to expel, the whole episode is really symbolic of Saint Patrick converting the natives to Christianity and banishing the Druids whose symbol was the serpent. But banishing the snakes makes a better story and to this day, Croagh Patrick attracts thousands of pilgrims who make the trek 765ft to the summit on the last day of July.
