## Winning entry will decorate Bishop Neary's Christmas card!

The Diocese of Saint Cloud invites artists of all ages to enter a diocesan-wide, poster-style art contest to design the image that will appear on the front of Bishop Neary's Christmas card this year. Artists may use drawing materials of their choosing. The art should have a religious theme and be completed on a sheet of paper measuring 8.5-by-11 inches (vertical or horizontal). Artists may choose to incorporate words and/or phrases into the art, but it is not required. The artist's name, address, telephone number and parish must be included on the back of the entry. Submissions will be judged on originality, artistic ability, and how well the artwork will reproduce. The winner will have an opportunity to meet Bishop Neary, and he or she will be credited for the artwork on the back of the card.
